Course: Ray Sand Buoy(P), Ray Sand North Buoy(P), Obstruction marked at N 51'44'190 E 00'59'159 (P, and ensure you pass at a safe distance), Tide Pole Cardinal Mark (Finish)

Please note that the fleet is to stay outside of the Bathing Area off of the power station.

Approximate distances:

RBYC to Ray Sand Buoy approx. 8nm

Ray Sand Buoy to Ray Sand North Bouy 1nm

Ray Sand North to Tide Pole approx. 8nm

Committee boat finish off the Tide Pole Cardinal Mark

Moor in Bradwell Marina. RIBs should be available to guide /tow RBODs.

The marina is expecting us

Transport back to Burnham.

## **EQUIPMENT**

Equipment to be carried on the RBODs; some items are required by Class Rules and will, no doubt, be on board anyway:-

1. Personal buoyancy for all on board
2. Anchor and long warp
3. Reefing equipment
4. Lifebuoy
5. Manual bilge pump (with secured handle)
6. Paddle
7. Bucket, tied to boat
8. Bailer
9. Flares
10. Compass
11. Torch with spare bulb and batteries
12. First-aid kit
13. Charts (corrected up to date)
14. GPS may be carried
15. VHF (capable of receiving Ch 72)
16. Stout tow rope
17. Fenders and mooring lines
18. Nurofen
19. Bradwell Pilotage notes
20. Lead line or handheld depth sounder.
